NYWEA Awards Harry Reiter of Hilton, NY

Syracuse – Harry M. Reiter of Hilton, NY was honored by the New York Water Environment Association (NYWEA) with the 2007 John Chester Brigham Award at its 80th Annual Meeting held in New York City in February. The award recognizes outstanding service to the Association.

Reiter is the pretreatment coordinator for the Monroe County Department of Environmental Services and manages the Industrial Waste Control (IWC) Section in Rochester. He began working for the department in 1974, has 28 years with the Industrial Waste Control Section and 14 years as the Pretreatment Coordinator. He has been a NYWEA member since 1994 in its Genesee Valley Chapter. For three years he has been active as chair of the Pretreatment Coordinators Committee and works on subcommittees of the Industrial Issues Committee. He holds a degree in civil environmental technology from Monroe Community College.
