Syracuse – The New York Water Environment Association (NYWEA) honored Jerry Werner of Dix Hills, NY with the 2007 John Chester Brigham Award at its 80th Annual Meeting held in New York City in February. The Brigham Award recognizes outstanding serving to the Association.

Werner is a 35-year member of NYWEA's Long Island Chapter, having served as its past chapter chair, secretary and vice chair/treasurer. In addition to being past chair of the Operations and Maintenance Committee, he has been instrumental in increasing the chapter's membership numbers and fundraising activities. He is past recipient of the L.I. Chapter's Outstanding Service Award and earned its Lifetime Achievement Award in 2007. Werner is a project manager for deBruin Engineering of Bethpage, NY, and is serving as assistant resident engineer on upgrading the Cedar Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant in Wantagh, NY.
