NYWEA Honors Andrew Sansone of Webster, NY

Syracuse – **Andrew Sansone** of Webster, NY was honored by the New York Water Environment Association (NYWEA) with the Milton T. Hill Award at its 80th Annual Meeting held in New York City in February. The Milton T. Hill Award recognizes outstanding contributions to the cause of improving the status of water pollution control personnel and operators through training and education.

Sansone is a senior industrial waste technician in the Pretreatment Office of the Monroe County Department of Environmental Services. His work includes extensive experience in water quality sampling and analysis for both fresh water and wastewater. He has been involved in efforts concerning pollution prevention program development and illicit discharge detection and elimination. He holds a BA degree in business from Ithaca College and a BS degree in water resources from SUNY Brockport. Sansone is a member of the Genesee Valley Chapter of NYWEA.
